These issues will add something different to your classroom with an aim to enhance and extend your students' learning and comprehension.

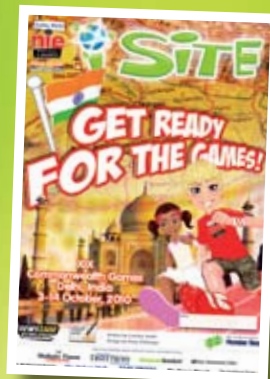

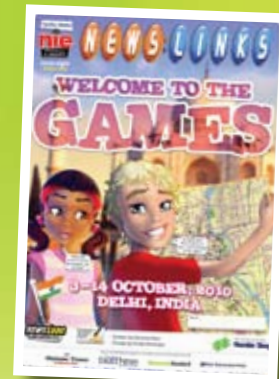

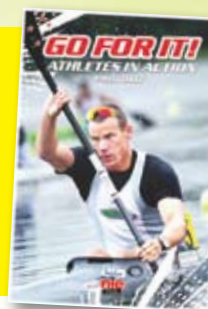
