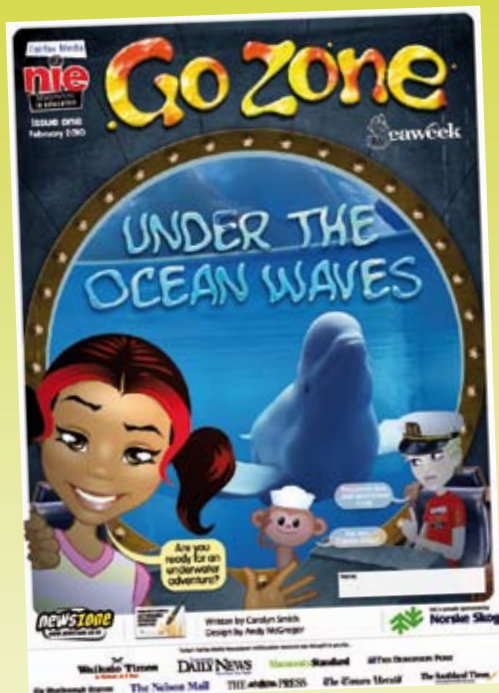


Take your students for a closer look under the ocean waves...
