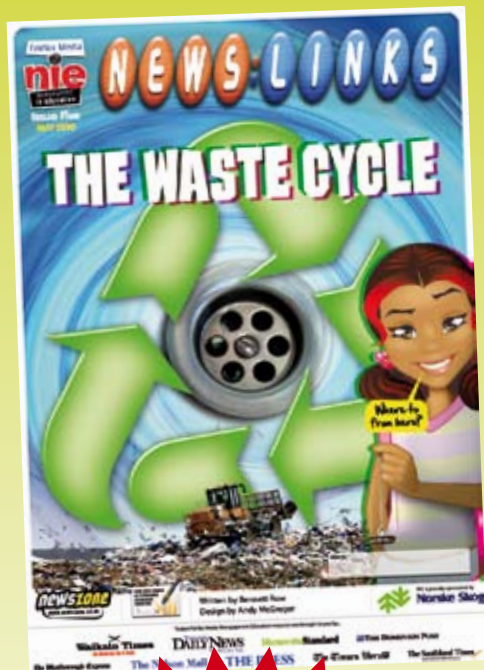


# Get Your Students Thinking About Our Environment
